I respectfully request that the ACC direct TEP to immediately reinstate the currently approved net metering rules. TEP cannot be allowed to brazenly act outside the regulation of the ACC by arbitrarily setting a June 1, 2015 date after which they will no longer honor the rate payer renewable energy contracts as legally established by the ACC.

The actions of TEP make it impossible for ratepayers to make an informed financial decision about purchasing and installing a solar PV system for their home or business. Consequently, the Tucson market for new solar installations has frozen and layoffs in the solar industry have harmed businesses, individuals and the economy. I am one who has lost a job as a direct result of TEP's self-serving monopolistic actions.

I respectfully request that the ACC assert it's mandated powers of regulation, deny TEP's audacious attempt to kill off ratepayer owned solar installations and reaffirm the current net metering rules.

TEP has stated that it will bring a rate case to the ACC in the next year or so; the community looks forward to evaluating their proposal with the ACC at that time.
