# GRAHAM COUNTY UTILITIES, INC.

## OFF-SITE HOOK-UP FEE STATUS REPORT

In Decision No. 71690, dated May 3, 2010, the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) approved "Off-Site Hook-up Fees" for Graham County Utilities, Inc. (GCU). The decision also required GCU to file an annual status report for the prior calendar year until the hook-up fee tariff is no longer in effect. The status report should contain the following information:

- A list of all customers that have paid the hook-up fee tariff.
- The amount each has paid.
- The amount of money spent from the tariff account.
- The amount of interest earned on the tariff account.
- A list of all facilities that have been installed with the tariff funds during the 12 month period.

Accordingly GCU is providing the required information in compliance with the order. The following chart lists all customers that have paid the hook-up fee tariff for the calendar year 2014. All of the hook-up fees collected were based on the 5/8" x 3/4" meter size.

The total amount of interest earned for this account through December 31, 2014 was \$14.66. GCU continues to service debt on existing off-site facilities and construct new off-site facilities including new wells, transmission lines, and other "back-bone" infrastructure for the benefit of the entire water system. However

none of the funds collected in 2014 were expended and continue to reside in a separate interest bearing account. GCU determined that not enough off-site hook-up fees had been collected to fund any new projects at this time. GCU will continue to monitor the off-site hook-up fee account and use funds according to the approved tariff when adequate funds become available.
