The Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") hereby provides notice that Respondent Henryk Jan Kunowski, aka H. Jon Kunowski, aka Jon Kunowski ("Kunowski") has been served with the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, For Restitution, For Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") by publication.

Pursuant to A.A.C. Rule R14-4-303(H)(1)(b) the Division may serve by publication when "The person has avoided service and service by publication is the best means practicable under the circumstances for providing notice of the administrative proceedings." The Division has attempted to serve Kunowski with a copy of the Notice at his confirmed place of residence on ten separate occasions:

1. By personal service where service was attempted on six separate occasions (see Affidavit of Michael Brokaw attached as Exhibit A) at the following dates and times:

- a) June 18, 2015, 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

1 d) July 2, 2015, 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

2 e) July 10, 2015, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

3 f) July 30, 2015, 10:00 a.m.

4 2. By sending a copy via commercial courier FedEx, who attempted delivery on three
5 separate occasions:

6 a) July 14, 2015, 1:43 p.m.

7 b) July 15, 2015, at 4:02 p.m.

8 c) July 16, 2015 at 3:54 p.m.

9 FedEx also left a notice on the door of the residence and held the package for pick up at
10 their local office starting on July 20, 2015, where it was unclaimed, (see Exhibit A,
11 Affidavit of Michael D. Brokaw with attached Exhibit 1: FedEx Tracking information).

12 3. By sending a copy by certified mail on September 28, 2015. The U.S. Postal Service
13 attempted delivery on September 30, 2015, at 9:54 a.m.. A notice was left stating the
14 certified mail could be picked up at the listed Post Office location or that arrangements
15 to have it redelivered could be made via the USPS.com website or by telephone. To date,
16 the certified mail has not been picked up nor redelivered. (see Exhibit A, Affidavit of
17 Michael D. Brokaw with attached Exhibit 2: Certified Mail Tracking information.)

18 In addition, on September 28, 2015, Kunowski was sent a copy of the Notice via e-mail and
19 asked to schedule a time and location convenient to him to accept service. Kunowski has not replied
20 to the e-mail to date, (see Exhibit A, Affidavit of Michael D. Brokaw with attached Exhibit 3: e-
21 mail).

22 The facts set out above and in the attached Exhibit A support that Mr. Kunowski is avoiding
23 service and pursuant to A.A.C. R14-4-303(H)(1)(b), service by publication is the best means
24 practicable under the circumstances for providing him with notice of the administrative proceedings.

25 According to A.A.C. R14-4-303(H)(2)(a), "The Division shall publish a statement regarding
26 the administrative proceedings at least once a week for four successive weeks in a newspaper

1 published in Maricopa County.” The Division published a statement that included the information
2 required by A.A.C. R14-4-303(H)(2)(b), in the Arizona Business Gazette, a Phoenix based
3 newspaper of general circulation in Maricopa County, Arizona on the following dates:

- 4 a) October 15, 2015
- 5 b) October 22, 2015
- 6 c) October 29, 2015
- 7 d) November 05, 2015


9 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-4-303(H)(3), service is complete 30 days after the first publication.

4 I, Michael D. Brokaw, hereby declare under oath that the following statements are true:


- 5 1. I am employed as a Senior Special Investigator for the Securities Division of the Arizona
6 Corporation Commission.
- 7 2. I am over the age of eighteen, have personal knowledge of the facts set forth below, and
8 am competent to testify.
- 9 3. During the investigation of this matter, I was notified by a reliable third party that the
10 current address for Henryk Jan Kunowski, a/k/a H. Jon Kunowski, a/k/a Jon Kunowski
11 ("Kunowski"), is 10003 W. Thunderbird Blvd, Sun City AZ 85351 ("residence").
- 12 4. A Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, For
13 Restitution, For Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") was
14 filed in the matter of Kunowski on June 18, 2015.
- 15 5. Along with Investigator Greg Thomsen, I attempted personal service of the Notice on
16 Kunowski at his residence on June 18, 2015, between 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. by ringing the
17 doorbell several times and knocking on the door. The rear entry door to the residence's back
18 patio was also checked. There was no answer to either door at Kunowski's residence.
- 19 6. Also accompanied by Investigator Greg Thomsen, I made additional unsuccessful attempts to
20 personally serve Kunowski at his residence during the following dates and times, again
21 ringing the doorbell several times and knocking on the door. The rear entry door to the
22 residence's back patio was also checked on each occasion.
 - 23 a) June 19, 2015, between 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.
 - 24 b) June 25, 2015, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
 - 25 c) July 2, 2015 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
 - 26 d) July 10, 2015 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

- 1 7. On July 13, 2015, I sent a copy of the Notice to Kunowski by FedEx, direct signature
2 required, with tracking number 8083 5029 7302 ("FedEx Package").
- 3 8. According to the FedEx website tracking print out attached as Exhibit 1, delivery of the FedEx
4 Package was attempted on the following dates and times:
- 5 a) July 14, 2015, 1:43 p.m.
6 b) July 15, 2015, at 4:02 p.m.
7 c) July 16, 2015 at 3:54 p.m.
- 8 9. A door tag notice of the attempted delivery was left by FedEx on the residence door on July
9 15, 2015, (Door Tag # DT104083160194). Starting July 20, 2015, the FedEx Package was
10 held for recipient pick up at the FedEx Office located at 4475 N. 43rd Avenue, Phoenix, AZ.
11 As of July 30, 2015, at 12:15 p.m., the FedEx Package had not been picked up and was still at
12 the FedEx Office.
- 13 10. On July 30, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., I again attempted personal service at Kunowski's residence
14 along with Investigator Greg Thomsen. No FedEx door tag was found on the front door or on
15 the rear entry door of Kunowski's residence.
- 16 11. We then made contact with an elderly neighbor who was unable to provide her neighbor's
17 name but stated that he had a bad leg and never answered the door. The description of
18 Kunowski matched information previously obtained during the investigation.
- 19 12. I later located the property owner of the residence on the Maricopa County Assessor's
20 Office website. I then contacted the property owner, who confirmed on August 5, 2015,
21 that Kunowski is renting the residence and currently lives there.
- 22 13. On September 28, 2015, I sent Kunowski a copy of the Notice via Certified Mail with
23 tracking number 7007 1490 0000 2605 3910. The U.S. Postal Service attempted delivery at
24 9:54 a.m. on September 30, 2015. A notice was left that arrangements could be made for
25 redelivery of the certified mail on the USPS.com website or by calling 800-ASK-USPS.
26 Alternatively, the certified mail could be picked up at the Post Office listed on the notice

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
until October 30, 2015. To date, the certified mail has not been picked up nor redelivered.

14. On September 28, 2015, Securities Division attorney James Burgess sent an e-mail to Kunowski attaching a copy of the Notice and asking him to schedule a time and place to accept service, (See the e-mail attached as Exhibit 3). To date, no response to the e-mail has been received.



Dear Mr. Kunowski:

On June 18, 2015, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") docketed a **NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST, ORDER FOR RESTITUTION, ORDER FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES, AND ORDER FOR OTHER AFFIRMATIVE ACTION** ("Notice of Opportunity for Hearing"), which the Securities Division filed against you. The case number is ACC Docket No. S-20928A-15-0199. The Notice of Opportunity for Hearing alleged that you engaged in acts, practices, and transactions that constitute violations of A.R.S. § 44-1841, A.R.S. § 44-1842, and A.R.S. § 44-1991. Please find a courtesy copy of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing attached to this email.

Between June 18 and July 10, 2015, Special Investigators Michael D. Brokaw and Greg Thomsen of the ACC's Securities Division made five (5) separate attempts to serve you with the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing at your home address of 10003 W. Thunderbird Ave. Sun City, AZ 85351. Each time they rang your front doorbell several times and knocked on your residence's front door and back door. There was never an answer at either door.

On July 13, 2015, Special Investigator Brokaw sent you the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing by FedEx to your residence. We tracked the letter on a daily basis. On July 15, 2015, FedEx left door tag on your door at 10003 Thunderbird Blvd. Sun City, AZ From July 21st to July 30th, 2015, the letter was held at the FedEx Office located at 4475 N. 43rd Ave. Phoenix, AZ.

On July 30th, 2015, Special Investigators Brokaw and Thomsen went to your residence again in another attempt to serve you. The FedEx door tag was not there. They rang your front doorbell several times and knocked on your residence's front door and back door. No one answered.

We are writing to inquire whether you will accept service of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing. If you will agree to do so, we can schedule a time at your convenience to deliver it to you. Please let us whether you will accept service and if so, when and where we can deliver it to you.

1 a) he and any of his agents and employees be permanently enjoined from
2 violating the Securities Act;

3 b) he was required to pay restitution of \$778,000 to the Commission, plus 10%
4 interest until paid;

5 c) he was required to pay a \$20,000 civil penalty for contempt to the
6 Commission, plus 10% interest until paid; and

7 d) he was required to pay a \$50,000 civil penalty pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-2037
8 to the Commission, plus 10% interest until paid.

9 9. Further, the 2006 Order directed and KUNOWSKI agreed that “he will not exercise
10 any control over any entity that offers or sells securities ... within or from Arizona.”

11 10. Of the \$848,000 in restitution and penalties the 2006 Order required KUNOWSKI to
12 pay, he paid only \$400.

13 11. In November 2012, KUNOWSKI invited several potential investors to his house in
14 Peoria, Arizona and gave a presentation concerning two projects he said he was developing.

15 12. KUNOWSKI said that for five (5) years, he had been “developing a twin micro-
16 turbine engine personal flight system and the world’s first true ‘Jet Pack’ that will allow for
17 practical human flight.”

18 13. KUNOWSKI’s presentation continued: “With flight times of 15 to 30 minutes, ‘Jet
19 Star’ will become a viable tool for first responders to save lives! The applications are as vast as the
20 imagination and include firefighters, paramedics, search and rescue, police, military, special
21 operations, industry, media, and of course, the consumer. ‘Jet Star’ represents a significant
22 technology breakthrough and a major aviation milestone.”

23 14. KUNOWSKI said he had also designed an unmanned aerial vehicle drone capable of
24 vertical takeoffs and landings.

25 15. KUNOWSKI told the potential investors that he needed to raise funds to pay patent-
26 related legal expenses and to purchase materials to build the jet packs and drones.

1 c) Omitting to disclose to investors that he has failed to pay \$847,600 in
2 restitution and penalties he owes the Commission;

3 d) Omitting to disclose to investors that the 2006 Order prohibited him from
4 exercising "any control over any entity that offers or sells securities ... within or from Arizona;"

5 e) Omitting to disclose to investors that in 2004 he had filed for bankruptcy.

6 f) Omitting to disclose to investors that he intended to use their investment funds
7 to pay his personal living expenses.

8 31. This conduct violates A.R.S. § 44-1991.

9 **VII.**

10 **REQUESTED RELIEF**

11 The Division requests that the Commission grant the following relief:

12 1. Order KUNOWSKI to permanently cease and desist from violating the Securities Act
13 pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 44-2032, 44-1961, and 44-1962;

14 2. Order KUNOWSKI to take affirmative action to correct the conditions resulting from
15 his acts, practices, or transactions, including a requirement to make restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§
16 44-2032, 44-1961, and 44-1962;

17 3. Order KUNOWSKI to pay the State of Arizona administrative penalties of up to five
18 thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each violation of the Securities Act, pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-2036;

19 4. Order KUNOWSKI to pay the State of Arizona administrative penalties, pursuant to
20 A.R.S. §§ 44-1961 and 44-1962; and

21 5. Order any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.

22 **VIII.**

23 **HEARING OPPORTUNITY**

24 Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-1972 and A.A.C. R14-4-306. **If**
25 **Respondent requests a hearing, Respondent must also answer this Notice.** A request for hearing
26 must be in writing and received by the Commission within 10 business days after service of this

1 Notice of Opportunity for Hearing. Respondent must deliver or mail the request to Docket Control,
2 Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Filing instructions
3 may be obtained from Docket Control by calling (602) 542-3477 or on the Commission's Internet web
4 site at <http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/hearings/docket.asp>.

5 If a request for a hearing is timely made, the Commission shall schedule the hearing to begin
6 20 to 60 days from the receipt of the request unless otherwise provided by law, stipulated by the
7 parties, or ordered by the Commission. If a request for a hearing is not timely made the Commission
8 may, without a hearing, enter an order granting the relief requested by the Division in this Notice of
9 Opportunity for Hearing.

10 Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language
11 interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting Shaylin A.
12 Bernal, ADA Coordinator, voice phone number 602/542-3931, e-mail sabernal@azcc.gov.
13 Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation.

16 **IX.**

17 **ANSWER REQUIREMENT**

18 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-4-305, if Respondent requests a hearing, Respondent must deliver
19 or mail an Answer to this Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Docket Control, Arizona
20 Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, within 30 calendar days
21 after the date of service of this Notice. Filing instructions may be obtained from Docket Control by
22 calling (602) 542-3477 or on the Commission's Internet web site at
23 <http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/hearings/docket.asp>.

24 Additionally, Respondent must serve the Answer upon the Division. Pursuant to A.A.C.
25 R14-4-303, service upon the Division may be made by mailing or by hand-delivering a copy of the
26

1 Answer to the Division at 1300 West Washington, 3rd Floor, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, addressed to
2 James D. Burgess.

3 The Answer shall contain an admission or denial of each allegation in this Notice and the
4 original signature of Respondent or Respondent's attorney. A statement of a lack of sufficient
5 knowledge or information shall be considered a denial of an allegation. An allegation not denied
6 shall be considered admitted.

7 When Respondent intends in good faith to deny only a part or a qualification of an
8 allegation, Respondent shall specify that part or qualification of the allegation and shall admit the
9 remainder. Respondent waives any affirmative defense not raised in the Answer.

10 The officer presiding over the hearing may grant relief from the requirement to file an
11 Answer for good cause shown.

JON KUNOWSKI has engaged in acts, practices, and transactions that constitute violations of A.R.S. § 44-1841, A.R.S. § 44-1842, and A.R.S. § 44-1991. 
