



27 seconds later: Impairment lingers when using in-car tech

Seemingly harmless acts cause a driver's mental distraction to persist up to 27 seconds after dialing, changing music or sending a text using voice commands. In a study recently released, AAA analyzed the lingering effects of voice-controlled technology.

fields before they become fully engaged.

In addition, researchers compared distraction levels of 10 hands-free technologies in vehicles and three types of smart phones. The information was used to rate levels of mental distraction similar to the Saffir-Simpson scale used to rank hurricanes (category 1 through 5). The best-performing was the Chevy Equinox with a cognitive distraction rating of 2.4, while the worst-performing system was the Mazda 6 with a rating of 4.6.

This is the third phase of AAA's landmark study on cognitive distraction. Phase 3's study comprised 257 drivers ranging in age from 21 to 70 years. A total of 65 people ages 21 to 68 participated in the evaluation of smart phones. Participants practiced operating the research vehicles and research tasks before each experiment. Their brainwaves, eye movement, reaction time and other metrics were evaluated by experts from the University of Utah.

As a safety advocate, AAA will use the results of this study to continue dialogue about distracted driving with policymakers and automakers.

The AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety partnered with researchers at the University of Utah to determine how much voice-controlled technology, which is supposed to make multitasking easier, affects our ability to drive safely.

Key findings include:

- Reaction time slowed for up to 27 seconds after the driver stopped interacting with the system.
 - Drivers 54 years old and older experienced greater cognitive distraction caused by these systems as compared to young and middle-aged drivers.
 - Practice reduced, but did not eliminate the mental distraction caused by these systems.
 - Voice-based smart phone interactions are significantly more distracting than typical cell phone conversations when it came to placing calls, selecting music or using voice commands to send a text message.
- Motorists could miss stop signs, pedestrians and other vehicles for nearly half a minute while their mind readjusts to the task of driving. Even at speeds of 25 miles per hour, drivers could travel the length of nearly three football
