27 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona
28 Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In Decision No. 71471 (January 26, 2010), the Commission approved a Territorial
Settlement Agreement ("TSA") between Graham County Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("GCEC" or
"Cooperative") and the City of Safford ("Safford"). Decision No. 71471 modified the Cooperative's
Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") and approved the transfer of certain service

1 territory, called the “Safford Service Area” (“SSA”) and the assets needed to serve that area from
2 GCEC to Safford.¹

3 2. Pursuant to Decision No. 71471, and the terms of the TSA, the transfer of assets would
4 occur over a number of years, with the initial transfer occurring December 31, 2012 (“Initial Transfer”),
5 and the final transfer occurring January 1, 2016 (“Final Transfer”). In order to determine that the Final
6 Transfer is in the public interest, Decision No. 71471 directed GCEC to file a new application with the
7 Commission in 2015 to request deletion of that portion of its CC&N within the SSA not deleted as part
8 of the Initial Transfer, and to authorize the transfer of the distribution assets used to serve the load
9 within the SSA. Decision No. 71471 specified that in approving the TSA, the Commission would not
10 be bound to approve the future application to modify the CC&N and that the parties would retain the
11 burden to prove that the future modification of the CC&N and transfer of assets is in the public interest.²

12 3. The Initial Transfer that transferred the Wal-Mart Supercenter to Safford and the Safford
13 Municipal Airport properties to GCEC, occurred smoothly on January 1, 2013.

14 4. On October 1, 2015, GCEC filed an Application to complete the transfer of assets and
15 service territory to Safford.³ Specifically, GCEC requests that the Commission: (1) delete from its
16 CC&N the portions of the SSA not already deleted by the Commission in Decision No. 71471; (2)
17 authorize the Cooperative to transfer to Safford all distribution assets used to serve the load within the
18 SSA; and (3) in order to ensure a smooth transition, to waive the Commission’s customer
19 confidentiality rule (A.A.C. R14-2-203(A)(2)) so that GCEC can transfer customer-specific
20 information to Safford.

21 5. On October 14, 2015, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Request for
22 Expedited Procedural Conference, in order to approve a schedule that would allow for a hearing and
23 final decision on the new application in December 2015, so that the January 1, 2016 transfer date could
24 be met. Staff’s filing contained a jointly proposed hearing schedule. In addition, Staff filed a
25 Memorandum confirming the legal description of the SSA territory.

1 6. On October 16, 2015, the parties appeared telephonically before the assigned
2 Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) and agreed on a procedural schedule that would allow for public
3 notice, pre-filed written testimony, and a hearing to commence on November 16, 2015.

4 7. On October 19, 2015, Staff filed a Notice of Filing, indicating that it had reviewed and
5 made proposed revisions to the proposed notice to affected customers contained in GCEC’s application.

6 8. By Procedural Order dated October 21, 2015, the hearing on the application was set for
7 November 16, 2015, and other procedural guidelines established, including the form of notice for the
8 hearing, to be mailed to affected GCEC customers and published in a local newspaper.

9 9. On October 20, 2015, GCEC filed the direct testimony of Kirk Gray, GCEC’s Assistant
10 General Manager, in support of the application. On October 26, 2015, GCEC filed supplemental
11 exhibits to Mr. Gray’s pre-filed Direct Testimony, including a rate comparison and Safford’s
12 Confidentiality Policy.

13 10. On November 6, 2015, GCEC filed a Declaration of Mailing confirming that GCEC
14 mailed the notice of the hearing to each of its customers in the SSA on October 30, 2015, and an
15 Affidavit of Publication confirming publication of the notice in the *Eastern Arizona Courier* on October
16 31, 2015.

17 11. On November 6, 2015, Staff filed its Staff Report, recommending approval of the
18 application.

19 12. On November 12, 2015, GCEC filed the Responsive Testimony of Mr. Gray, seeking
20 modification of certain of the recommendations contained in the Staff Report.

21 13. On November 16, 2015, the hearing convened as scheduled before an authorized ALJ
22 at the Commission’s Tucson offices. Mr. Steve Lines, the Cooperative’s General Manager, and Mr.
23 Gray, its Assistant General Manager, testified for GCEC; Ms. Blessing Chukwu and Ms. Margaret
24 Little, testified for Staff. Safford appeared at the hearing through counsel; and although not sponsoring
25 a witness, expressed support for the application. The Commission has not received any written or oral
26 public comments in this matter. Following the hearing, the ALJ took the matter under advisement,
27 pending the issuance of a Recommended Opinion and Order.

28 14. During the hearing, Mr. Lines agreed to waive the 10-day exception period, and on

1 November 17, 2015, GCEC filed a formal waiver of the 10-day exception period in order to facilitate
2 consideration of this matter at the Commission's December Open Meeting.

3 **The TSA and Final Transfer**

4 15. GCEC was formed in 1944 and received its CC&N in 1962. It is a non-profit,
5 member-owned electric distribution cooperative that serves areas located south and east of the San
6 Carlos Apache Indian Reservation, excluding locations served by Safford and the Town of Thatcher.
7 At the time it filed its application, GCEC served approximately 6,500 members.⁴

8 16. Safford is a municipal corporation of the State of Arizona that operates an electric
9 distribution system both within and outside of its corporate limits.

10 17. Prior to 1946, the Arizona General Utilities Company ("AGU") was the sole provider
11 of electric service within Graham County. In 1946, GCEC, Safford and the Town of Thatcher jointly
12 acquired the assets of AGU. Safford and Thatcher acquired the AGU assets within their city limits,
13 while GCEC acquired the remaining assets. The entities entered into an agreement ("1946 Agreement")
14 that attempted to spell out their respective rights and obligations to provide electric service in the area.
15 One provision of the 1946 Agreement addressed Safford's future annexation of areas within GCEC's
16 CC&N territory. Although this provision attempted to clarify the parties' respective rights in the event
17 of annexation, it proved to be the subject of significant disputes between the parties and led to animosity
18 and multiple lawsuits. To prevent continued disputes, GCEC and Safford entered into the TSA in
19 December 2008 to resolve the ambiguities of the earlier agreement.⁵

20 18. The TSA clarifies each party's service rights and responsibilities within the corporate
21 limits of Safford and establishes a procedure for any future territory expansion by Safford. At the time
22 the parties executed the TSA, Safford did not have the infrastructure and system capabilities in place
23 in order to immediately serve the load within the SSA.⁶ Consequently, the TSA provided that GCEC
24 would continue to service the existing (and any new) customers located within the SSA until Safford
25 was ready to serve the area. The TSA provided for two separate transfers from GCEC to Safford. The

1 Initial Transfer occurred in January 2013 under which Safford took over service to the Wal-Mart
 2 Supercenter and GCEC assumed service to the Safford Municipal Airport properties. The Final
 3 Transfer will transfer the remaining SSA and is the subject of the current application.

4 19. The SSA is described in Exhibit A hereto. The locations within the SSA which were not
 5 transferred from GCEC to Safford in Decision No. 71471, and which are part of the Final Transfer are
 6 described in Exhibit B hereto.⁷

7 20. Since the inception of the TSA, GCEC and Safford have worked together to complete
 8 the necessary infrastructure and system upgrades so that Safford will be able to serve the load within
 9 the SSA. Safford upgraded its substation, including a 69 kV transmission switching capability in order
 10 to facilitate GCEC's new 69 kV double circuit into the substation to provide transmission loop feed.
 11 Safford also upgraded a primary distribution line to handle the load in the SSA after the Final Transfer.

12 21. As of October 1, 2015, GCEC served a total of 778 electric meters in the SSA which
 13 will be transferred to Safford when the Final Transfer is implemented. The final number may change
 14 because there are active developments in the area, and GCEC may add new customers before December
 15 31, 2015.

16 22. GCEC requests that the Commission authorize the transfer to Safford of all distribution
 17 assets used to serve the load within the SSA. A list of the facilities serving the SSA that were in use as
 18 of January 1, 2009, are attached hereto as Exhibit C. A list of the facilities serving the SSA that CGEC
 19 added subsequent to January 1, 2009 is attached as Exhibit D. Because the number of assets and the
 20 facilities used to serve the SSA may increase between the date of the application and the Final Transfer,
 21 GCEC requests that the Commission authorize the transfer to Safford of facilities identified on Exhibits
 22 C and D as well as any facilities that GCEC may construct within the SSA prior to the Final Transfer.⁸

23 23. Under the TSA, Safford will pay GCEC the replacement cost less depreciation

1 (“RCLD”) of the facilities that were in place on January 1, 2009, but not less than \$950,000 or greater
2 than \$1,250,00, plus the cost of facilities GCEC installed after January 1, 2009.

3 24. The RCLD of the facilities that existed as of January 1, 2009 is \$662,892.99, which is
4 less than the minimum price set forth in the TSA. At the end of August 2015, the cost of the facilities
5 installed between January 1, 2009 and August 2015 was \$24,529.41. With the additional facilities
6 expected to be installed from September 2015 until the Final Transfer, GCEC expects the final purchase
7 price to be in the neighborhood of \$975,000.⁹

8 25. GCEC argues that the benefits of the TSA and Final Transfer include: (1) the resolution
9 of a long-standing dispute between GCEC and Safford for service rights in and around Safford; (2) a
10 more peaceful coexistence between GCEC and Safford given the agreed process for future Safford
11 annexations and because the Cooperative will continue to provide transmission wheeling services to
12 Safford; (3) financial benefits the Cooperative will derive from the purchase price and future wheeling
13 revenue; and (4) the avoidance of litigation in connection with Safford’s current acquisition and future
14 annexations.¹⁰

15 26. Current GCEC customers in the SSA will be subject to Safford’s rates which are similar
16 to those they pay currently. A comparison of the rates for GCEC and Safford follows:¹¹

8 27. The TSA calls for the Final Transfer to take place on or after December 31, 2015. In
9 order to coordinate the process, including final meter reading, Safford and GCEC have scheduled the
10 transfer to begin on January 4, 2016.

11 28. Section 16 of the TSA requires GCEC to provide Safford with customer lists, addresses,
12 billing information, load histories and other relevant account information. As a result, GCEC requests
13 that the Commission waive the customer confidentiality rule. After the Final Transfer, GCEC will send
14 a final bill to the transferred customers based on the final meter reads, and customers who have a
15 deposit on file will receive a deposit refund, as a bill credit, or check, if the deposit exceeds the final
16 bill.

17 29. Section 7 of the TSA requires GCEC to make monthly payments to Safford if
18 Commission authorization is not received in time for the January 4, 2016 Final Transfer. Consequently,
19 GCEC requests expedited processing to achieve consideration of the application at the Commission's
20 December 2015 Open Meeting.

21 30. Staff investigated the application, including an engineering analysis of Safford's facility
22 improvements, and as a result concluded that: (1) Safford is capable of operating the electrical assets
23 that will be transferred and of providing safe and reliable service to the customers being transferred
24 from GCEC; (2) Safford is ready, willing, and able to provide service in the SSA and has taken steps
25 to ensure that the same quality of service would be provided to the customers within the SSA who have
26 been receiving electric service from GCEC; (3) no detrimental impact to service reliability will occur
27 as a result of the transfer; (4) GCEC provided notice of the transfer and of the hearing to its affected
28 customers; (5) the proposed modification of GCEC's CC&N and transfer of assets is in the public
interest; and (6) the transfer of customer-specific information from GCEC to Safford is necessary to

1 effectuate the transfer and would best serve the public interest.

2 31. Staff recommends that: (1) the Commission grant GCEC's request to delete from its
3 CC&N the portion of the SSA excluded from Decision No. 71471; (2) the Commission approve
4 GCEC's request to transfer to Safford all distribution assets used to serve the load within the SSA; (3)
5 the Commission grant GCEC's request to transfer customer-specific information to Safford; (4) the
6 Commission require GCEC to file with Docket Control, within seven (7) days after the hearing in this
7 Docket, late-filed exhibits consisting of a documentation showing the final purchase price, an updated
8 list of affected customers and an updated list of the facilities within the SSA to be transferred to the
9 City; (5) GCEC be authorized to engage in any transactions and to execute or cause to be executed any
10 documents so as to effectuate the authorizations requested with the application; and (6) GCEC be
11 required to file all pertinent documents evidencing the consummation of the transaction no later than
12 30 days from the effective date of the transaction.

13 32. Because the final list of facilities to be transferred to Safford will not be known until the
14 date of the Final Transfer on January 4, 2016, GCEC does not believe that filing the updated list of
15 facilities or final purchase price (which is dependent on the final list of assets) prior to the Final Transfer
16 is possible or necessary.¹² In addition, with respect to Staff's recommendation to file all pertinent
17 documents evidencing the consummation of the transaction, GCEC does not object to confirming the
18 consummation of the transaction, but proposes that the compliance filing be limited to a bill of sale, or
19 similar document confirming receipt of final payment along with a final list of the facilities transferred
20 to Safford.

21 33. Staff did not object to GCEC's proposed modifications to Staff's recommendations.

22 **Resolution**

23 34. The Commission approved the TSA in Decision No. 71471, finding the agreement to
24 be in the public interest. Under the terms of the approved agreement, the area described in Exhibit B
25 would remain part of GCEC's CC&N pending a future application to transfer these locations to Safford.
26 The evidence presented in this proceeding indicates that the TSA has operated as intended and that

1 Safford continues to be a fit and proper entity to provide electric service within the entire SSA territory.
2 In the intervening years since the parties executed the TSA, Safford has worked to improve the facilities
3 that serve the SSA, and is prepared to serve the area. Safford has provided electric service to its citizens
4 since at least 1946. According to GCEC, the parties worked cooperatively to improve the facilities, and
5 the TSA has resulted in vastly improved relations and cooperation between GCEC and Safford vis-a-
6 vis utility service.

7 35. Customers who will be transferred from GCEC to Safford will experience similar rates
8 to their current rates. Safford will not charge a connection fee to new customers received in the Final
9 Transfer.

10 36. Based on the totality of evidence, we find that the final transfer of service territory and
11 assets as contemplated by the TSA we approved in Decision No. 71471 is in the public interest, and
12 should be approved.

13 37. The transfer of customer-specific information, including customer names, addresses,
14 billing information, load histories and other relevant information will facilitate the transfer of service
15 to Safford to the benefit of all parties, including the affected customers. Safford already provides other
16 utility service (e.g. water and gas) within the SSA. Safford also has a Confidentiality Policy that
17 prevents disclosure of customer specific information without prior written consent except for law
18 enforcement requests, collection purposes or as necessary to provide safe and reliable service. Safford's
19 policy substantially conforms to Commission Rule A.A.C. R14-2-202(A)(2).¹³

20 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

21 1. GCEC is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV,
22 Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281, 40-282 and 40-285.

23 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over GCEC and over the subject matter of the
24 application.

25 3. Notice of the application was provided as required by law.

1 4. Safford is capable of operating the electrical assets that will be transferred, and of
2 providing safe and reliable service to the customers being transferred from GCEC.

3 5. The modification of GCEC's CC&N and transfer and sale of assets to Safford, as
4 described in the application, and at the hearing, is in the public interest.

5 **ORDER**

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Final Transfer as described in the Territorial Service
7 Agreement between Graham County Electric Cooperative, Inc. and the City of Safford, is approved,
8 and Graham County Electric Cooperative Inc.'s Certificate of Convenience and Necessity is modified
9 to delete the locations within the Safford Service Area not already deleted pursuant to Decision No.
10 71471, as described in Exhibit B hereto.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Graham County Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall transfer to
12 the City of Safford all distribution assets used to serve the load within the Safford Service Area.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that A.A.C. R14-2-203(A)(2) is waived to allow Graham County
14 Electric Cooperative, Inc. to share customer-specific information with Safford in connection with the
15 Final Transfer.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Graham County Electric Cooperative, Inc. is authorized to
17 engage in any transactions and to execute or cause to be executed any documents necessary to
18 effectuate the authorizations approved herein.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of the Final Transfer, Graham County
2 Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall file with Docket Control, as a compliance item in this Docket,
3 documentation showing: (1) that the Final Transfer has been consummated, (2) the final purchase price,
4 and (3) all of the facilities and meter locations that were transferred to the City of Safford.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
