On or about December 9, 2015 or as soon thereafter as regulatory approval can be obtained from the Arizona Corporation Commission, Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") will no longer provide Sprint wireline consumer long distance services and associated features. This discontinuance does not impact any Sprint wireless services that you have.

This discontinuance impacts all of your Sprint 1+ dialed calls.
