Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On October 28, 2015, the Commission issued Decision No. 75293 in the above-
captioned matter, granting EPCOR Water Arizona, Inc. ("EPCOR") a wastewater certificate of
convenience and necessity ("CC&N") for a service area located in the vicinity of Luke Air Force Base
and the Loop 303 in Maricopa County.

2. Also on October 28, 2015, EPCOR filed a Request for a Procedural Order Correcting
the Recommended Opinion and Order and Anticipated Decision, Nunc Pro Tunc ("Request"). In the
Request, EPCOR stated that while setting up the rates for the new service area (now to be known as
the "Luke 303 Wastewater District"), EPCOR discovered that the commodity rate for
commercial/industrial 1 1/2" meter customers had been omitted from the Recommended Opinion and
Order. EPCOR further stated that although the commodity rate had been included in its Revised Exhibit

1 7 filed on May 8, 2015,¹ it had been omitted from the Revised Staff Report filed on July 13, 2015.²
2 EPCOR stated that Staff agrees the omission was not intentional. EPCOR requests that a Procedural
3 Order be issued to correct page 50 of the Recommended Opinion and Order and anticipated Decision
4 in this matter *nunc pro tunc* to reflect a commodity rate of \$4.19 per 1,000 gallons and no commodity
5 charge cap for commercial/industrial 1 1/2" meter customers in the Luke 303 Wastewater District.

6 3. The omission of the commercial/industrial 1 1/2" meter commodity rate and cap
7 information in the Recommended Opinion and Order and Decision No. 75293 was wholly inadvertent
8 and an error.

9 4. Decision No. 75293 incorrectly omitted, on page 22, immediately after line 25, and on
10 page 50, immediately after line 20, the commodity rate and cap information for commercial/industrial
11 1 1/2" meters. These omissions should be corrected, *nunc pro tunc*, by inserting the following:

12 (a) On page 22, immediately after line 25:

13 "Commercial/Industrial 1 1/2" Meter (No Cap) 4.19 N/T"

14 (b) On page 50, immediately after line 20:

15 "Commercial/Industrial 1 1/2" Meter (No Cap) 4.19"

16 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

17 1. EPCOR is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article 15 of the Arizona
18 Constitution and Title 40 of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

19 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over EPCOR and over the subject matter of this
20 matter.

21 3. The commodity rate and cap information set forth in Findings of Fact No. 4 is just and
22 reasonable for EPCOR's Luke 303 Wastewater District and was omitted inadvertently due to clerical
23 error.

24 4. Decision No. 75293 should be corrected, *nunc pro tunc*, as described in Findings of Fact
25 No. 4.


