



On November 13, 2015, Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("Company" or "Applicant") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order authorizing Applicant to secure long-term financing in an amount not to exceed \$31,167,500. The purpose of the financing is to fund certain improvements, upgrades and replacements to the Company's generation plant anticipated to be needed over the next several years. The Application also seeks authorization to modify the facilities to be financed without the need to file an amended application, so long as the total amount financed does not exceed the amount originally authorized by the Commission. The Commission may approve, disapprove, or approve the financing request with modifications. The Commission may act on the financing request with or without a hearing.


