MAXIMUM RATES FOR CENTURYLINK FACILITY RELOCATION CHARGES

CenturyLink has filed an application pursuant to Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Rule R-14-2-1110 to implement a Facility Relocation charge along with a **maximum allowable** rate to allow recovery for unreimbursed costs associated with mandated government related facility moves. This proposal will be voted on at an Open Meeting of the Commission and will become effective only upon approval by the Commission.

If CenturyLink's application is approved, the actual rate could not exceed a maximum rate of \$3.00 per access line. The proposed actual rate for the first twelve months will be \$1.00 per access line.

HOW TO SUBMIT PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE APPLICATION

Written public comments may be submitted by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-1051B-15-0382 to the Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, or by email. For a form to use and instructions on how to e-mail comments to the Commission, go to www.azcc.gov and click on "submit a public comment for a utility". INTERVENTION

If an evidentiary hearing is requested on this matter, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you wish to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send a copy of the motion to CenturyLink or its counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address and telephone number of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself.
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.
4. Unless the proposed intervenor is an individual representing himself or herself, or is represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, information and any appropriate documentation demonstrating compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38 and 42 as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105. For information about requesting intervention, visit the Commission's website at www.azcc.gov/divisions/utilities/forms/interven.pdf. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE AT THE COMMISSION'S OPEN MEETING ON THIS MATTER

The Commission's Utilities Division Staff is in the process of reviewing and analyzing the application and has not yet made a recommendation regarding CenturyLink's request. The Commission will issue a Decision regarding the application at an upcoming Open Meeting. Notice of the Commission's Open Meetings every month can be found on its website. You may also provide public comments when the Commission considers the matter at an upcoming Open Meeting.
