**APPLICATION TO INTERVENE
AND SUPPORT FOR MOTION TO EXTEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Sun City Homeowners Association ("SCHOA") hereby applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an Order granting it leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In addition, SCHOA expresses its support for the Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule filed by the Arizona Utility Ratepayer Alliance ("AURA") on January 26, 2016.

On January 19, 2016 the Company ("UNSE"), in its rebuttal testimony filed a significant change from its initial application, essentially abandoning the two part rate design set forth in its initial application and proposing new rates and rate designs consistent with the Staff-proposed three part rate design noted in its December 9, 2015

1 testimony, thus changing the entire substance and dynamics of this case. This is
2 particularly true with the proposal for mandatory demand charges for residential and small
3 business customers, which is a major fundamental change very late in the UNSE
4 proceeding.

5 This case has suddenly become of interest to Arizona Public Service Company
6 (“APS”) and thus a number of parties such SCHOA, which represent the interests of the
7 customer/ratepayer. This interest stems from the dramatic changes in policy recently
8 proposed by UNSE, Staff, and APS, as well as heightened awareness regarding the
9 ultimate possible negative consequences that a precedent-setting decision in the UNSE
10 proceeding could impose upon the thousands of ratepayers in the upcoming APS rate
11 case scheduled to be filed in June 2016. Also of note, is the APS intervention in the UNSE
12 rate case and the APS filing of major direct testimony and the sponsoring of an expert
13 witness in the rate case proceeding of another utility, which is highly unusual.

14 We therefore request to be included as intervenors and we support the AURA
15 motion for an extension of the procedural schedule for a minimum of sixty days to allow for
16 those who are now affected due to the recent dramatic changes in the UNSE-proposed
17 rate designs as well as the recent proposals by the ACC Staff and the unusual actions
18 taken by APS in this case to participate fairly and fully in the UNSE proceeding. The
19 extension of the procedural schedule should include an extension of the schedule for
20 intervention to allow for our intervention in the UNSE proceeding.

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


