




Subject: Links at Coyote Wash Utilities, LLC – Docket# SW04210A-10-0392  
Compliance Item – Bi-annual Update on Odor Complaints & Actions taken

Since our last update on July 20, 2015, the operators & management of Links at Coyote Wash Utilities, LLC (LACW) received zero formal odor complaints and one informal odor complaint. The most recent complaint was in September. We were unable to identify the source of the complaint in September, as we checked the manholes closest to the customer's property and we could not find any backups, nor were any odors detected by staff.

The upgrade/ expansion of the WWTP is nearly complete as of the date of this letter. We believe that these improvements, along with our work with Town of Wellton on their automatic dosing system, and with additional sewer connections in the more remote sections of the collection system, will prevent sewage from sitting in the collection system for an inordinate amount of time, and reduce odors when the sewage arrives at the WWTP. We also continue to benefit from the increased time that the plant is being maintained. Daily visits from our onsite maintenance staff, who perform the routine maintenance and cleaning of the WWTP, are keeping odors to a minimum.
