PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 31, 2015, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase.

On October 5, 2015, the Arizona Solar Deployment Alliance ("ASDA") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene in this docket. ASDA is a non-profit organization that is comprised of solar companies that install solar arrays in the Company's service area.

On October 6, 2015, Arizona Solar Energy Industries Association's ("AriSEIA") filed an Application to Intervene in this docket. AriSEIA is a non-profit trade association that represents local and national companies whose mission is to promote policies that promote greater use of solar energy in Arizona.

On October 6, 2015, by Procedural Order, the matter was set for hearing to commence on May 17, 2016, and other procedural guidelines were established.

On October 26, 2015, by Procedural Order, ASDA and AriSEIA were granted intervention.

On October 29, 2015, Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Trico") filed an Application to Intervene in this docket. Trico is a member-owned non-profit electric cooperative that provides electric service to members in Pima, Pinal, and Santa Cruz Counties.

1 On November 2, 2015, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed an Application to
2 Intervene in this docket. APS is a public service corporation providing electric service to customers
3 within the State of Arizona.

4 On November 5, 2015, SSVEC filed a Notice of Consent to E-Mail Service.

5 On November 10, 2015, by Procedural Order, SSVEC's Notice was granted.

6 On November 12, 2015, APS filed a Consent to Email Service.

7 On November 12, 2015, by Procedural Order, Trico and APS were granted intervention.

8 On November 13, 2015, Staff filed its Notice of Consent to E-Mail Service.

9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the request by Staff and APS to receive service of all
10 filings in this docket, including all filings by interested persons and Staff and all Procedural Orders and
11 Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the Commission's Hearing
12 Division, via their designated email address rather than via U.S. Mail, is hereby approved.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a person's election to receive service of all filings in this
14 matter via email does not change the requirement that all filings with the Commission's Docket Control
15 must be made in hard copy and must include an original and 13 copies.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
17 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
18 hearing.

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
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
