**Re: PaeTec Communications, LLC (T-03663A)**

Docket Control:

PaeTec Communications, Inc. became a Delaware LLC on April 8, 2015, and is now known as PaeTec Communications, LLC. The Arizona Corporation Commission issued PaeTec Communications, Inc. a certificate of convenience and necessity ("CC&N) to provide competitive interLATA/intraLATA resold telecommunications services on April 14, 2000 (Decision 62458). This letter is simply to notify the Arizona Corporation Commission that the correct name for this utility is now "PaeTec Communications, LLC" and ask that the utility name be updated in the eDocket filing system.<sup>1</sup> PaeTec Communications, LLC obtained from the Commission a Certificate of Registration in Arizona as a foreign limited liability company on May 14, 2015.

PaeTec Communications, LLC will reissue AZ C.C. Tariff No. 1 to reflect this name change. Thank you for your assistance.

<sup>1</sup> No approval for this transition from "Inc." to "LLC" is required. PaeTec Communications, Inc. was a Delaware corporation and under Delaware law, "all property, real, personal and mixed, and all debts due to such other entity, as well as all other things and causes of action belonging to such other entity shall remain vested in the domestic limited liability company to which such other entity has converted." Del. Code Title 6 § 18-214(f). Accordingly, the PaeTec Certificate of Convenience and Necessity continues to be vested in the corporate entity, which is now converted to an LLC.
