UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS Electric"), through undersigned counsel, submits the attached proposed witness schedule in accordance with the January 25, 2016 procedural order in this docket. As requested in the procedural order, UNS Electric and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") coordinated discussions among all parties to develop a schedule for witness testimony. The parties conducted two conference calls to discuss witness availability and other issues related to witness testimony. In preparing the schedule, the parties attempted to group witnesses by general topics of testimony to the extent feasible. The parties also discussed possible stipulated testimony and telephonic appearances. The proposed schedule identifies such witnesses. It is possible that additional telephonic testimony may be proposed or agreed to upon review of the upcoming surrebuttal testimony.

The schedule also was prepared to fill up the available hearing days. Given that surrebuttal testimony has not been filed, the parties did not discuss the amount of cross-examination for each witness. However, based on the discussions of the parties and the comments of the parties, it appears that the proposed schedule is reasonable at this point given the current dates for hearing.

1 Finally, it appeared to be the consensus of the parties that it would be helpful to receive
2 preliminary guidance from the Hearing Division as the general acceptability of the proposed
3 schedule and the potential for stipulated or telephonic testimony. Such guidance will allow the
4 witnesses to make travel plans further in advance.
