I am a TEP customer and am very concerned that Tucson Electric Power will propose rate and fee increases that will result in higher electrical service charges for solar customers. These increases would also act as a disincentive to other customers like me who are interested in participating in distributed power generation by having solar panels installed on their property.

As the ACC takes up a review of the value and cost of solar power and the future of distributed generation in Arizona, I hope that you will seriously consider the economic impact of rate and fee hikes on electrical utility customers. Since 2015r, TEP is owned by Fortis Energy Services, Inc. a multibillion, multinational energy corporation. We look to you to support DG, to support a strong solar energy program and, to protect the pocketbooks of Arizona's citizens.

I am an intervener in the "generic" docket on smart meters, E-00000C-11-0328. The issues raised by many citizens statewide regarding these radio wave transmitting meters and their effect on health, privacy, etc. have yet to be resolved. At the last hearing on this docket, held during December 2014, I recommended against Arizona Corporation Commission acceptance of the Arizona Department of Health Services smart meter report. This report entirely missed the mark in being biased towards the telecommunications and electrical power industry view that there is no credible evidence of harm from smart meters. The report contained many flaws, which I presented formally in writing and in person at the hearing. This docket is still open. I highly recommend this docket be incorporated by reference in these proceedings and that hearing is held to accept testimony from Arizonans who are being adversely affected by wireless signals from transmitting meters, including AMI and AMR meters. The Rural Electrical Cooperatives was granted a waiver by the ACC in 2001 and is not required to give opt outs to its customers, many of whom are suffering health problems related to these meters.

Finally, I want to bring to your attention the International EMF Scientist Appeal to the United Nations, and its sub organizations, the World Health Organization and the U.N. Environmental Programme. I direct this international initiative. Since this Appeal was initially filed in May of 2015, the number of EMF scientists who have signed it has grown to 220 signators from 41 nations. These scientists have all published EMF papers that show biological and health effects at low intensity levels, far below the international EMF exposure guidelines.
