Notice of Suspension of a Measure

Pursuant to Decision No. 74406 (March 19, 2014):

[I]f Arizona Public Service Company finds any Commission-approved program or measure is no longer cost-effective, Arizona Public Service Company shall file, in this docket, a letter stating that the program or measure will be discontinued.

Arizona Public Service (APS or Company) suspended its Appliance Recycling Program in November of 2015, after its vendor, JACO, ceased business operations. Since that time, JACO has gone into receivership and released all of its local employees engaged in appliance recycling work. APS has reviewed other vendors that offer a similar service; however, the vendor's costs are significantly higher. Due to the higher costs, this program will no longer be cost-effective. This letter provides notice that APS will indefinitely suspend its Appliance Recycling Program as of March 1, 2016.
