**REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME FOR COMPLIANCE FILING**

Dear Commissioners:

On March 23, 2006, the Commission entered a decision on the Arizona Water Company application to extend its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CC&N) to allow Arizona Water Company additional time to file a series of compliance items in order to fulfill the requirements of the Commission Decision.

Prior to the Decision of the Commission, the City of Eloy filed exceptions to the Recommended Opinion and Order, dated January 31, 2006, objecting to the extension of Arizona Water Company's CC&N for Parcel 3 and Parcel 8.

The City's exception to Parcel 3 in 2006, stated that "Parcel 3 is immediately contiguous to Eloy's city limits and within Eloy's planning area and proposed service expansion." The City also objected to Parcel 8 since it is located within Eloy's city limits.

Since that time, Arizona Water Company has filed for several time extensions because of their inability to comply with the requirements of Commission's decision on the CC&N. The most recent extension of time was granted by the Commission on June 30, 2014 and ends on March 23, 2016. The current matter before the Commission, filed by Arizona Water Company, would grant another extension of time to March 23, 2018.

The City of Eloy currently has water lines within one-half mile of the eastern side of Parcel 3 (Section 36, T7S, R6E) and has annexed all of Parcel 2 (Section 25). An existing city water line is in place and in service on the eastern boundary of Parcel 2. Also, Parcel 8 is completely within the City of Eloy's municipal boundaries.

It is clear that the City of Eloy has long intended to serve the areas covered by Parcels 2, 3 and 8. The City has already extended water service to the area. Each of these areas has been within the City's planning area for many years and the City has annexed much of the areas surrounded by these parcels.

The City believes that it has shown its commitment to serve the areas covered by Parcels 2, 3, and 8. Arizona Water Company has had ten years to satisfy the Commission's directives for serving these areas, and have failed to perform its required actions as directed by the Corporation Commission. Therefore the City of Eloy respectfully requests that Parcel 3 be removed from the CC&N expansion as part of Arizona Water Company's request for a further extension of time in this case. Further, the City of Eloy wishes to confirm that Parcel 8 lies within the City's water service area and that Arizona Water Company has no authority to serve Parcel 8.
