PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 5, 2015, (“UNSE” or “Company”) filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for a rate increase.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that UNS Electric, Inc., shall provide public notice of the public comment sessions, in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 18 point bold type and the body in no less than 10 point regular type:

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **UNS Electric, Inc., shall cause a copy of the notice to be**
26 **published** at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the appropriate affected service areas,
27 with publication to occur no later than March 18, 2016.

28 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **UNS Electric, Inc., shall file, no later than March 31,**
29 **2016, an affidavit demonstrating compliance with the notice requirements** in this Procedural
30 Order.

31 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing/publication
32 of same, notwithstanding the failure of an individual customer to read or receive the notice.

33 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of
34 the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro*
35 *hac vice*.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
2 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
3 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at
4 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled
5 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
6 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
8 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
9 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended
11 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
13 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
14 hearing.
