Jeff,

This will confirm that I contacted you this morning to ask if SSVEC would consent to EFCA filing its Direct Rate Design Testimony on April 1, 2016 and that SSVEC indicated that it would not consent and would, in fact, oppose such filing. I explained that EFCA relied upon the Procedural Order issued in the case as that Procedural Order appears, on the Commission's docket site, as if it is the most recently issued Procedural Order. Upon noticing that Staff filed on March 18, 2016, EFCA researched why that would have occurred and found that, on the Commission's docket website, the Procedural Order modifying the schedule oddly appears below the original Procedural Order on which EFCA relied. This would suggest that the originally issued PO was the most recent PO and that the PO below it was modifying something issued earlier in time.

It is unfortunate that your client would not be more amenable to amicably resolving this issue and instead is going to force both parties to expend time and energy fighting this issue. I will note for you that Staff has already confirmed to me it has no objection to EFCA filing its testimony on April 1 and we will be representing that to the judge. As a result of SSVEC's refusal to agree to this simple extension, this will confirm that EFCA will be filing a Motion to be granted leave to file its direct rate design testimony on April 1. As you know, EFCA still has the right to file surrebuttal testimony in this action so it is not as if your client's position is going to result in EFCA being forbidden from participating. In addition, as I mentioned on the phone, we are happy to agree to offer SSVEC additional time to provide its rebuttal testimony to make up for any perceived issue with shortening the time between EFCA's direct and the company's surrebuttal. With this in mind, let me know if your client changes its mind prior to our filing our Motion.
