

**INSUFFICIENCY LETTER**

Dear Ms. Spain:

In reference to the above-mentioned application by Parker Lakeview Estates Homeowners Association, Inc., d/b/a Parker Springs Water Company ("Parker Springs" or "Company") docketed on February 22, 2016, for partial deletion of territory in its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"), this letter is to inform you that Staff of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") is still in need of further information to determine sufficiency requirements in the most recent Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C") R14-2-402 (ACC Water Rules).

Please provide the following clarification/information in reference to your application:

1. Per your correspondence with Lori Miller of our Engineering Department, please provide a revised legal description and map.
2. The above-referenced ACC Water Rules require that all landowners (not just customers) in a current CC&N area be notified of applications proposing any changes to the certified territory. If the Company has not already notified all landowners within the current Parker Springs CC&N boundaries of proposed charges, please do so and advise Staff of such notification.
3. Please advise Staff if the Company is currently providing service to any entities outside its certified territory.
4. Additionally, please advise if there are any customers currently being served that are in the proposed deletion area.

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Pursuant to A.A.C. R-14-2-411(C), upon meeting sufficiency requirements, the Commission has 150 days for its substantive review. This includes conducting a hearing and preparing a Recommended Opinion and Order to present to the Commission at an Open Meeting.
