**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Grants Consent to Service by Email**  
**And**  
**Notification of Intervention)**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On November 5, 2015, Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP” or Company”) filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for a rate increase.

On March 2, 2016, the Arizona Solar Energy Industries Association (“AriSEIA”) filed an Application to Intervene. AriSEIA is a nonprofit trade association comprised of local and national companies to promote policies that encourage the use of solar energy in Arizona. AriSEA’s board passed a resolution to allow its Chairman, Tom Harris, to represent it in this proceeding.

On March 3, 2016, The Alliance for Solar Choice (“TASC”) filed an Application for Leave to Intervene. TASC is a solar energy advocate association whose membership includes the “majority of the Nation’s rooftop solar market, including Demeter Power Group, Geostellar, Inc., LGCY Power, REPOWER by Solar Universe, Sunrun Inc. and SunTime Energy.

There have been no objections to the requests to intervene.

AriSEIA opted to receive service of all filings in this docket, including all filings by parties and all Procedural Orders and Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the Commission’s Hearing Division, via its designated email addresses rather than via U.S. Mail. This party exercised this option, pursuant to the Procedural Order issued on December 14, 2015, by

1 docketing a hard copy of their Consent to Email Service by sending an email, containing the consenting

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **intervention is granted to AriSEIA and TASC.**<sup>1</sup>

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request by **Arizona Solar Energy Industries**  
8 **Association** to receive service of all filings in this docket, including **all filings by parties and all**  
9 **Procedural Orders and Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by**  
10 **the Commission's Hearing Division**, via its designated email addresses rather than via U.S. Mail, is  
11 hereby approved.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a party's election to receive service of all filings in this matter  
13 via email does not change the requirement that all filings with the Commission's Docket Control must  
14 be made in hard copy and must include an original and 13 copies.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
16 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision  
17 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or  
19 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
20 hearing.
