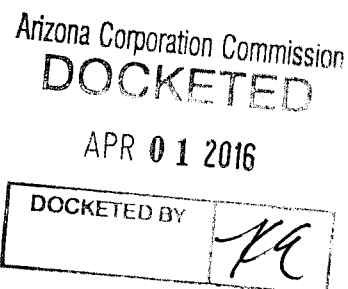

Dear Chairman Little,

JM Eagle is dedicated to the growth and prosperity of our region and our state, which is why we strongly support UniSource Energy Services' proposal for new rates. UniSource has requested approval of more equitable rates for all electric customers that will enhance the economic competitiveness of the Kingman and Lake Havasu area and Mohave County.

The changes, as originally proposed, will more closely match rates to actual costs. As a result, some commercial customers will see reduced energy costs if those rates are approved.
