Dear Commissioners, At issue before the Commission is whether to keep retail net metering, which pays solar owners the retail rate of electricity for the power they export to the grid, or whether to let TEP and APS replace it and impose extra charges on solar owners. APS and TEP say retail rate NEM is cutting into their revenues and imposing unfair costs for grid maintenance on customers without solar power. I find it difficult to comprehend how distributive generation by home owners which amounts to a tiny fraction of all power generation can be imposing an unfair burden. Leave net metering as it is for home owners; it is a small group, but represents a diverse population of forward-thinking individuals who have chosen to not only take advantage of photovoltaic generation and a conducive climate, but to reduce their carbon footprint on an increasingly stressed environment.
