STIPULATION BETWEEN
ALECA AND IM TELECOM, LLC

IM Telecom, LLC, d/b/a Infiniti Mobile ("Infiniti Mobile") and the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association ("ALECA") submit the following stipulation concerning Infiniti Mobile's Application in this docket:

1. Infiniti Mobile is seeking ETC designation in Arizona, including on the lands of Federally Recognized Tribes in Arizona.
2. To address potential ALECA concerns with this requested designation, Infiniti Mobile agrees that it will not provide Lifeline service to eligible residents residing on the lands of Federally Recognized Tribes in Arizona unless or until Infiniti Mobile has obtained any and all necessary licenses or other forms of approval that may be required by a Tribe. Before providing such service on tribal lands, Infiniti Mobile would file a copy of the tribal license or other form of approval with the Arizona Corporation Commission in Docket No. T-20924A-15-0007, with a copy to ALECA's undersigned counsel.
3. To ensure that Infiniti Mobile does not inadvertently provide service to residents of the lands of a Federally Recognized Tribe for which Infiniti Mobile has not

1 obtained all necessary licenses or other forms of approval, Infiniti Mobile further
2 agrees that its Lifeline enrollment application for Arizona will:

- 3 (a) Require an applicant to provide a street address; and
4 (b) Include a provision that requires an applicant under penalty of perjury
5 (i) to self-certify that he or she does not reside on the lands of a Federally
6 Recognized Tribe in Arizona, or (ii) to identify the Federally Recognized
7 Tribe on the lands of which he or she resides.

8 If the applicant does reside on the lands of a Federally Recognized Tribe for
9 which Infiniti Mobile has not received the approvals identified in Paragraph 2,
10 Infiniti Mobile will not provide service to the applicant.


- 11 4. Given this stipulation, ALECA does not oppose Infiniti Mobile's Application in
12 this docket and does not believe that a hearing is necessary to address ALECA's
13 concerns.
