

NOTIFICATION OF INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 5, 2015, Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP" or Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase ("Rate Case").

By Procedural Order dated December 14, 2015, the Rate Case was set for hearing to commence on August 31, 2016, and other procedural guidelines were established. One of the guidelines provided that parties could opt to receive service of all filings in the docket by Email.

By Procedural Order dated April 6, 2016 the Rate Case was consolidated with TEP's 2016 REST Implementation Plan (Docket No. E-01933A-15-0239).

On March 28, 2016, Arizona Community Action Association ("ACAA") and Cynthia Zwick filed a Motion to Intervene in the Rate Case. Both ACAA and Ms. Zwick, ACAA's Executive Director, serve the interests of low income Arizonans living within TEP's service territory. The Motion indicates that ACAA has authorized Ms. Zwick to represent the organization in this matter.

1 On March 29, 2016 Western Resource Advocates ("WRA") filed a Motion to Intervene in the
2 Rate Case. WRA is a non-profit regional environmental law and policy organization serving six
3 western states including Arizona.

4 On March 30, 2016, Southwest Energy Efficiency Project ("SWEEP") filed a Motion to
5 intervene in the Rate Case. SWEEP is a non-profit public interest organization that promotes greater
6 energy efficiency in the Southwest, including Arizona.

7 On April 1, 2016, Intervenor Sierra Club filed a Motion to Withdraw an Attorney. Sierra Club
8 requested that Nellis Kennedy-Howard be removed from the service list, and reports that Sierra Club
9 will continue to be represented by Travis Ritchie in the matter.¹


10 On April 5, 2016, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc., and Sam's West, Inc. (collectively "Wal-Mart") filed
11 an Application for Leave to Intervene in the Rate Case. Wal-Mart is a retailer with 21 stores in TEP's
12 service territory.

13 There has been no opposition to any of these requests to intervene.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that ACAA's, SWEEP's, WRA's and Wal-Mart's Requests
15 to intervene are granted.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Nellis Kennedy-Howard shall be removed from the service
17 list.
