PROCEDURAL ORDER (Schedules Hearing)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 27, 2015, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 75315, a Complaint and Order to Show Cause ("OSC") against the following named Respondents for failing to file their 2013 Utilities Division Annual Reports ("Annual Reports").

3 Therein, the Commission ordered a hearing to be conducted at a date and time set by the Hearing
4 Division.

5 Accordingly, it is appropriate to establish the procedural schedule for this matter.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **Procedural Conference shall be held on January 12,**
7 **2016, at 10:00 a.m.,** at the Commission's Phoenix Offices, Hearing Room No. 1, 1200 W. Washington
8 St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") shall file by
10 **January 8, 2016,** a memorandum in this Docket indicating which, if any, of the above-named
11 Respondents have filed 2014 Annual Reports since the issuance of Decision No. 75315.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **hearing** on the OSC shall be held on **January 20, 2016,**
13 **at 10:00 a.m.,** or as soon thereafter as is practicable, at the Commission's Phoenix Offices, Hearing
14 Room No. 1, 1200 W. Washington St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules
16 31, 38, and 42, and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as permitted under A.A.C. R14-3-107(B), each party to this
18 matter may opt to receive service of all filings in this docket, including all filings by parties and all
19 Procedural Orders and Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the
20 Commission's Hearing Division, via email sent to an email address provided by the party rather than
21 via U.S. Mail. To exercise this option, a party shall:

- 22 1. Ensure that the party has a valid and active email address to which the party has regular
23 and reliable access ("designated email address");
- 24 2. Complete a Consent to Email Service form, available on the Commission's website
25 (www.azcc.gov);
- 26 3. File the original and 13 copies of the Consent to Email Service form with the
27 Commission's Docket Control, also providing service to each party to the service list;

- 1 4. Send an email, containing the party's name and the docket number for this matter, to
2 HearingDivisionServicebyEmail@azcc.gov from the designated email address, to allow
3 the Hearing Division to verify the validity of the designated email address;
- 4 5. Understand and agree that service of a document on the party shall be complete upon
5 the sending of an email containing the document to the designated email address,
6 regardless of whether the party receives or reads the email containing the document;
7 and
- 8 6. Understand and agree that the party will no longer receive service of filings in this
9 matter through First Class U.S. Mail or any other form of hard-copy delivery, unless
10 and until the party withdraws this consent through a filing made in this docket.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a party's consent to email service shall not become effective
12 until a Procedural Order is issued approving the use of email service for the party. The Procedural
13 Order shall be issued only after the party has completed steps 1 through 4 above, and the Hearing
14 Division has verified receipt of an email from the party's designated email address.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a party's election to receive service of all filings in this matter
16 via email does not change the requirement that all filings with the Commission's Docket Control must
17 be made in hard copy and must include an original and 13 copies.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
19 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
20 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
22 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona
23 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all hearings
24 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for
25 discussion unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
26 Law Judge or the Commission.


