PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 29, 2016, Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) filed a Notice of Intent to File a Rate Case Application and Request to Open Docket.

Parties to this docket are Richard Gayer, Patricia Ferré, Warren Woodward, IO Data Centers, LLC (“IO”), and the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”).

On April 4, 2016, Freeport Minerals Corporation (“Freeport”) and Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition (“AECC”), filed a Motion to Intervene.

Also on that date, Freeport and AECC opted to receive service of all filings in this docket, including all filings by parties and all Procedural Orders and Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the Commission’s Hearing Division, via their designated email addresses rather than via U.S. Mail. 3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Freeport and AECC are hereby granted intervention.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the requests by Freeport and AECC to receive service of all
5 filings in this docket, including all filings by parties and all Procedural Orders and Recommended
6 Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the Commission's Hearing Division, via their
7 respective designated email addresses rather than via U.S. Mail, is hereby approved.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a party's election to receive service of all filings in this matter
9 via email does not change the requirement that all filings with the Commission's Docket Control must
10 be made in hard copy and must include an original and 13 copies.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
12 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
13 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
15 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
16 hearing.
