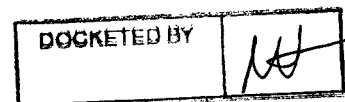


Dear Chairman Little and members of the Commission:

My clients, Local Unions 769 and 1116 of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO, CLC, respectfully request that in advance of, and in conjunction with, your forthcoming deliberations in the above-referenced matter, that you read and consider Scott Northrup's testimony IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMISSION'S INVESTIGATION OF VALUE AND COSTS OF DISTRIBUTED GENERATION, ACC Docket No. E-00000J-14-0023. Mr. Northrup's direct testimony was filed on February 25, 2016 and his rebuttal testimony was filed on April 7, 2016. Mr. Northrup appeared and testified in person at the hearing on the morning of April 19, 2016.

While IBEW Locals 769 and 1116 did not seek intervention in UNS Electric's general rate case, they do believe that their unique position *vis-à-vis* the so-called "cost of solar" ought to be considered by the Commission in conjunction with the resolution of the instant, and extremely important, case.
