Arizona utilities and is responsible for approving rate changes, so no utility should be allowed to make or indicate that it can make any rate related changes before an ACC decision. Finally, the utilities know roughly how long it takes the ACC to decide a rate case, so why should a utility's customers be surprised and penalized for the lack of planning on the part of the utility? 3. I do not support the ACC staff recommendation to eliminate the banking of excess kWh and the elimination of the current SSVEC net-zero process. The ACC staff talked about the possibility of DG customers installing DG systems that produce far in excess of the DG customer's needs. I believe SSVEC has created a net-zero process that has precluded this from happening and could make further enhancements to ensure it does not happen in the future.
