NOTIFICATION OF INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 5, 2015, Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP" or Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase ("Rate Case").

By Procedural Order dated December 14, 2015, the Rate Case was set for hearing to commence on August 31, 2016, and other procedural guidelines were established.

By Procedural Order dated April 6, 2016, the Rate Case was consolidated with TEP's 2016 REST Implementation Plan (Docket No. E-01933A-15-0239).

On April 27, 2016, Tucson Meadows, LLC ("Tucson Meadows") the owner and operator of the Tucson Meadows mobile home community in Tucson, and customer of TEP, filed an Application for Leave to Intervene in this matter.

On April 28, 2016, the following entities requested intervention:

- (1) the Southern Arizona Home Builders Association ("SAHBA"), a non-profit corporation that represents southern Arizona businesses in connection with

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development and home building matters, and which has many members located within TEP's service area;

- (2) the Secretary of Defense on behalf of the United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies ("DoD/FEA") DoD/FEA maintains military installation in Arizona, including Fort Huachuca and Davis-Monthan Ari Force Base which are large customers of TEP;
- (3) the Arizona Competitive Power Alliance (the "Alliance") comprised of members who supply electricity; and
- (4) SOLON Corporation ("SOLON") a turnkey commercial solar developer and contractor headquartered in Tucson since 2007.

On April 29, 2016, motions to intervene were filed by:

- (1) Bruce Plenk, a resident of Tucson and current residential customer of TEP; and
- (2) Arizona Solar Deployment Alliance ("ASDA"), an association of local solar installation companies.

No party opposed any of the requests to intervene.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **Intervention** Requests by **Tucson Meadows, ASDA, SAHBA, DoD/FEA, SOLON, the Alliance, and Mr. Plenk** are granted.

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
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
