PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Consolidates Dockets and Approves Email Service)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 16, 2016, Eagletail Water Company, LLC (“Applicant” or “Company”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) the above-captioned applications requesting approval of a financing application and approval of a rate increase, respectively.

Both of the applications were filed by the Company’s Managing Member, Ms. Susan Haas. Both applications also include the name of Ms. Michelle Sharp as the Company’s consultant. Ms. Sharp has sent an email with her email address to the Hearing Division at the Commission at HearingDivisionServiceByEmail@azcc.gov which has been received by the Hearing Division.

On May 4, 2016, Ms. Sharp filed a hard copy of a Consent to Email Service as the consultant to the Company.

On May 11, 2016, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Letter of Sufficiency which found the rate application met the sufficiency requirements of Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-103. Staff also filed a Motion to Consolidate the two proceedings.

Since Staff has stated that the matters are interrelated, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-109(H), the proceedings should be consolidated for further processing of the applications.

It does not appear that Ms. Sharp is an attorney authorized to practice law in Arizona and can represent the Company before the Commission, or that she is entitled to an exemption pursuant to Rule

1 31 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona, but as a courtesy, Ms. Sharp's Consent to Email
2 Service as the Company's consultant should be approved.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the above-captioned applications of Eagletail Water
4 Company, LLC for approval of financing and for approval of a rate increase shall be consolidated for
5 purposes of further processing and a hearing, if necessary.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request by Ms. Michelle Sharp as the Company's
7 consultant to receive service of all filings in this docket, including all filings by interested persons and
8 the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") and all Procedural Orders and all Recommended Opinion
9 and Orders/ Recommended Orders issued by the Commission's Hearing Division, via her designated
10 email address rather than via U.S. Mail is hereby approved.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31, 38, 39 and 42 of the
12 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and
13 admission *pro hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as permitted under A.A.C. R14-3-107(B), each party to this
15 matter may opt to receive service of all filings in this docket, including all filings by parties and all
16 Procedural Orders and Recommended Opinions and Orders/Recommended Orders issued by the
17 Commission's Hearing Division, via email sent to an email address provided by the party rather than
18 via U.S. Mail. To exercise this option, a party shall:

- 19 1. Ensure that the party has a valid and active email address to which the party has regular
20 and reliable access ("designated email address");
- 21 2. Complete a Consent to Email Service using the form available on the Commission's
22 website (www.azcc.gov) or a substantially similar format;
- 23 3. File the original and 13 copies of the Consent to Email Service with the Commission's
24 Docket Control, also providing service to each party to the service list;
- 25 4. Send an email, containing the party's name and the docket number for this matter, to
26 HearingDivisionServicebyEmail@azcc.gov from the designated email address, to allow
27 the Hearing Division to verify the validity of the designated email address;
