Respondent Union Pacific Railroad Company ("Union Pacific"), and the City of Avondale ("Avondale"), by and through their attorneys undersigned, hereby jointly request that the procedural conference set for **May 18, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.**, be vacated. Union Pacific and Avondale have been in contact with one another multiple times over the last week, and are discussing the remaining portions of the Avondale project and the corresponding construction timeline. Union Pacific and Avondale request that the procedural conference be vacated to allow the parties to continue their dialogue, and anticipate that a procedural conference may ultimately be unnecessary.

Accordingly, Union Pacific and Avondale respectfully request that the Administrative Law Judge Hesla vacate the procedural conference scheduled for May 18, 2016. In the event that Union Pacific, Avondale, or another stakeholder thinks that a procedural conference would be beneficial in the future, that party could then request one. Union Pacific and Avondale, however, anticipate

1 that they will be able to reach an agreeable construction schedule, and will notify the Commission
2 once they do and have resolved the City's objection.


