Dear Commissioner,

We support SSVEC's rate proposal to reduce the subsidy given by ordinary ratepayers to solar users.

We understand that this will be accomplished by raising monthly service fees while providing a corresponding reduction in the kilowatt hour rate.

While we support efforts to promote more solar and renewable energy, we believe that requiring unreasonable subsidies paid by one class of ratepayers to another is unfair and counterproductive.

We are aware that SSVEC tried for years in good faith to negotiate a fair deal for all concerned and was rebuffed time and time again by solar industry lobbyists who rejected any reasonable proposal, thus compelling SSVEC to file for these rate adjustments.

We urge you to approve the SSVEC proposal. It is a fair and reasonable approach that will allow solar development to continue without imposing unfair hidden costs on the 97% of ratepayers who do not have solar units on their homes.
