

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CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Yarnell Water Improvement Association has applied to the Arizona Corporation Commission for an adjustment in rates. The current rates have been in effect since February/2009. An increase in rates is necessary at this time due to operating expenses exceeding operating income.

Based on the Company's unaudited Test Year results, Yarnell Water Improvement Association realized an operating loss of \$45,395. The Company is requesting a revenue increase of \$87,737 or 41.04 % of total revenues. Please see the attached pages 9 and 11 of the Company's application for the current and proposed rates.

The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix at 1200 West Washington Street (for Tucson, call 800-535-0148 if located outside the Tucson local calling area or 520-628-6555 if inside the Tucson local calling area) and at Yarnell Water Improvement Association, 22609 Lookaway, Yarnell, AZ.
