I wish to respectfully request that the Arizona Corporation Commission to please allow for a second extension to allow me to respond to APS' MTD. My husband is a disabled combat veteran, and I am his full time caregiver through the VA. As of right now between my worsening health and caring for him, we are also in the process of preparing for an upcoming Social Security hearing June 22. We both have health testing and doctor appointments everyday this week. The VA works extremely slow and I am still trying diligently to get legal assistance on this matter. I do not feel comfortable enough handling this by myself without any legal experience or representation, nor is it fair that I do it alone without proper counsel and go up against a huge company whom retains many lawyers on each case. I have had a hard time in retaining pro bono counsel in this matter. I therefore respectfully ask that you allow an extension to the APS' MTD and the hearing on June 16, 2016, to allow me to either to try and continue to seek to retain counsel or get some kind of assistance in this matter. I also will not be available that day due to a health procedure and a doctor appointment scheduled. I stand firm in my formal complaint in this matter against APS and it would not be fair if this were to be dismissed. APS is a huge power company, that even though they may be "regulated" I have proof of their inaccuracies over the past five years I have resided in my home, and believe there is a grave injustice and unethical issues going on with their billing. I have been closely monitoring my bills in the last 12 months compared to the past four years, and it clearly shows that they have over billed me, acting not only illegally but unethically. I would respectfully like a fair opportunity to be able to prove my case. I ask that you give me 60 days to comply with my request. If I am not given the opportunity, I feel that you would be putting a disabled veteran and his family in grave danger to be without electricity.
