I understand the nature of rising costs and that Liberty Utilities is entitled to adjust business processes in order to be profitable. That being said, nearly doubling the monthly bill to any select group of individuals, without providing any new or improved service to their customers, is completely unreasonable. They should not be allowed to their customers like this because they've made poor business decisions in the past, and don't feel they're making enough money off the deal they made. Should this go into effect it will negatively effect, not just the residents, but other local businesses as well. The money will have to come from somewhere - some residents will doubtless have to cancel gym memberships, stop frequenting local Gold Canyon (and other metro city markets) restaurants/coffee shops/etc., cut their grocery budget, etc. Residents will receive no added benefit for this dramatic increase and, doubtless, this measure moving forward would impact housing sales in the area, at a time when the market is just stabilizing.
