I urge you to work for the residential expansion of solar electric. Doing away with Net Metering is a death note to residential solar. We currently have 4200 watts of installed solar on our home. We are on the TRICO system and are glad to pay the \$19.50 monthly connection charge and also the extra charge for net metering. I agree that we need to help maintain the power lines and infrastructure and are glad to have these costs increased as necessary.

Changing the net metering policy is very destructive. Solar will continue to expand and you should do everything in your power to assist home owners. With ever increasing population the use of residential solar will help to reduce or eliminate the need for future commercial power production.

Net metering is our 'battery' and allows us to produce 95% of our yearly power needs. TRICO and TEP need to make adjustments for the future. Solar is the future especially in states such as Arizona.

Please do not make a mistake and eliminate net metering or make it cost prohibitive for residential use of solar electric.

Residential solar should not produce more than they need on a yearly basis utilizing net metering. Payments for excessive power produced on a yearly basis can be reimbursed at the wholesale rate so it encourages residential solar to produce only what is needed on a yearly basis.

Solar is the future. Don't be influenced by commercial power companies that wish to increase revenue beyond what is actually needed. We do not need additional power production if residential solar is encouraged.
