STAFF'S REQUEST FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Utilities Division Staff ("Staff"), through undersigned counsel, hereby moves for a procedural schedule in the above-captioned matter. Staff notified Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or "Company") on July 1, 2016, that its Application met the sufficiency requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-103. Staff requests that the procedural schedule set forth below be adopted for this case. Staff believes that this is a balanced and fair schedule and should provide sufficient time to conclude the case within 12 months of the sufficiency finding so that new rates could take effect in July 2017.


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1 Staff has discussed this proposed schedule with counsel for APS and the Residential Utility
2 Consumer Office ("RUCO"). Both APS and RUCO have indicated to Staff that they are in
3 agreement with the proposed schedule and have authorized Staff to make such a representation on
4 their behalf.

5 Staff further requests that the ALJ schedule a procedural conference, if needed, to discuss the
6 schedule and other procedural matters the parties may have concerning the processing of this case.

7 WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that a rate case procedural order be issued adopting
8 the procedural schedule set forth above and that a procedural conference be held to discuss the
9 proposed schedule and other procedural matters regarding the processing of this case as the ALJ and
10 parties deem necessary.
