PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Administratively Closes Docket)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 13, 2016, Clear Rate Communications, Inc. ("Clear Rate") filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Arizona.

On May 13, 2016, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Deficiency indicating that the application did not meet the sufficiency requirements outlined in Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-502.

On July 5, 2016, Clear Rate filed a letter to withdraw its CC&N application.

On July 15, 2016, Staff filed a Memorandum indicating it has no objection to Clear Rate's request to withdraw its CC&N application. Staff recommends this docket be administratively closed.

No further filings have been made in this docket.

Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket No. T-20963A-16-0127 is hereby administratively closed.
