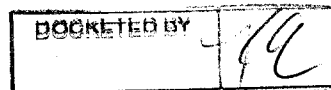

I am writing you concerning UniSource's proposed rate increase for Mohave County, Arizona. After reading the proposal in it's entirety, I have some concerns. I have been contemplating adding solar panels to my residence in Mohave County for the last several years. The lower price of solar, has me very close to going through with this decision. However, after reading UniSource's proposal, it seems they are leaving very little incentive for people to add solar. I understand some of their justification, but I don't agree that solar customers use the grid so differently, that extra costs are incurred. Their request that all solar customers be put on a "demand charge" plan seems very unfair. Especially considering they claim the law says they have to treat both solar and non-solar customers the same. Since residential consumers are not familiar with how demand charges work, it makes it very difficult to decide to add solar. From what I understand, it is almost impossible to predict, or even know what your demand may be. I called UniSource for some help trying to understand how it may work, and even their own people don't know. I am still waiting for a call back from someone from UniSource to explain it to me. Dear Mr Chairman,

I have been a home owner in Arizona since 2009 when my wife and I decided to retire in Lake Havasu City, AZ. My wife is working her last two weeks in Fort Myers, Florida and I have a couple of months left before I retire and we will reside full time in Lake Havasu City. Being unable to increase the amount of money we have to live on in retirement we decided that decreasing our electric bill would be a worthy goal. We are the owners of 2 electric cars and looked forward to producing our own transportation fuel as well. Two months ago our 10KW solar system was completed and we borrowed some of the money so we could pay cash for it. As of our last UES electric bill we have generated 2200 KWH of electricity and pumped it into the grid. I was counting on being compensated fairly for the electricity I produced through net metering. I understand it is in your power and it is your responsibility as well as the rest of the Commission to keep our solar system from being a financial disaster for us. We are forced by local regulation to be grid tied so disconnecting from the grid and installing batteries is not an option. Please do your best to keep our retirement from being an impoverished one. Paying retail for power used outside of the time we are producing and being paid much less for excess power we produce as well as a monthly solar fee would be disastrous for us.
