PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 22, 2016, Parker Lakeview Estates Homeowners Association, Inc. d/b/a Parker Springs Water Company (“Parker” or “Company”), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application to delete a portion of the Company’s Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.

On May 5, 2016, the Company filed an amended application to include the extension of its CC&N to an area currently served by Parker (together with the February 22, 2016, application, the “Application”).

On May 9, 2016, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) submitted its Sufficiency Letter, stating that Parker’s Application met the requirements of Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-402.

In a Procedural Order issued June 6, 2016, a hearing was scheduled to begin on July 19, 2016.

On July 22, 2016, the Company requested that the hearing be rescheduled due to the unavailability of the Company’s representative.

Staff did not object to Parker’s request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled to begin on July 28, 2016, is vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that public comment shall be taken on July 28, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission’s offices, Room 222, 400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona 85710.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **hearing in this matter shall begin on August 23, 2016,**  
2 **at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, Room 222, 400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona, 85701.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Parker shall file a corporate resolution authorizing its**  
4 **representative to represent the Company at hearing on or before August 12, 2016.**

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **time clock in this matter is extended to November 4,**  
6 **2016.**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized  
8 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter is set for public hearing.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or  
10 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
11 hearing.
