FINDINGS OF FACT

1. UNS Gas, Inc. (“UNSG” or “the Company”) is engaged in providing natural gas service within portions of Arizona, pursuant to authority granted by the Arizona Corporation Commission.
2. UNSG provides natural gas service in Apache, Navajo, Santa Cruz, Yavapai, Coconino, and Mohave counties. The Company has approximately 139,000 Residential customers, and 13,000 Commercial customers, along with a small number of Industrial and Resale customers, for a total of approximately 152,000 customers.

DSM Bank Balance

3. On April 1, 2016, UNSG filed an application in the Docket requesting to reduce its Demand-Side Management Adjustor from the current \$0.0005 per therm, to zero per therm. Currently, UNSG has an over-collected balance of approximately \$900,000. In order to pay it down, the Company is proposing to use the balance to fund its energy efficiency programs. UNSG states that it will submit a request to reset the DSM surcharge once the over-collected balances approaches elimination.

1 3. The Commission, having reviewed the application and Staff's Memorandum dated June,
2 28, 2016, concludes that it is in the public interest to approve a decrease in the DSM surcharge, from
3 \$0.0005 per therm to zero.

4 ORDER

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the decrease in the DSM surcharge from \$0.0005 per
6 therm to zero be approved, as herein discussed.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the DSM surcharge be decreased to zero effective August
8 1, 2016 and remain at zero until further action of the Commission.


9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision become effective immediately.


