REQUEST FOR ELIGIBILITY AND
SUFFICIENCY DETERMINATION

On July 26, 2016, Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("MEC") filed its Application requesting the establishment of new rates under the streamline procedure established by A.A.C. R14-2-107 (the "Rule"). Notice (in a form approved by Commission Staff) of MEC's intent to file its Application was mailed to MEC's member-customers on July 6, 2016 pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-107.C.5. The Notice established August 5, 2016 as the deadline for customers to file objections and/or requests to intervene with the Commission in accordance with A.A.C. R14-2-107.F. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-107.G, objections received after August 5, 2016 may not be considered by Staff in determining MEC's eligibility to proceed under the Rule.

Under A.A.C. R14-2-107.B.14 MEC remains eligible for the Rule 107 process unless a minimum of 1,000 objections are timely filed (i.e., by August 5, 2016). As of August 9, 2016 no objections have been received.
