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

Dear Commissioners,

As a Russell Ranch resident, I am pleased to hear the details of a settlement proposal in the EPCOR wastewater case, and strongly urge you to cast your votes in favor of this important first step to granting relief for Agua Fria ratepayers.

At the same time, I want to emphasize that there is still much work to be done on the part of the Commission to ensure that equitable and reasonable rates are established for ALL EPCOR ratepayers over the long term. I am speaking in particular of the need to reach a decision on **FULL CONSOLIDATION** of EPCOR's wastewater (and ultimately, water) districts.

Of all of the districts currently administered by EPCOR, only Agua Fria has significant opportunity for growth. This also means that the burden of all of the expansion and unused capacity is placed on Agua Fria ratepayers. We did not commission or approve the over-sized plants, yet as residents of these communities, we are forced to pay for customers that don't exist. **FULL CONSOLIDATION** is the most equitable means of distributing this portion of company costs across all ratepayers.

Over time, ALL ratepayers are in varying stages of causing cost or subsidizing it. Our neighbors in Sun City and Sun City West will soon be shouldering the burden of much needed capital improvements. As EPCOR embarks on construction of the West Valley Regional Water Reclamation Facility, still more unused capacity will need to be carried by the existing customer base. The **only way** to ensure stability and fairness is to distribute those costs as broadly as possible. The Commission has been discussing the issue of consolidation for at least fifteen years. As the formal rate case moves forward, it's high time action was taken.

Thank you for your time and consideration. As this issue moves forward into a new phase, we look forward to working closely with you and the other affected parties to ensure a successful outcome.
