**JOINT STIPULATION TO STAY
DOCKET**

Johnson Utilities, L.L.C. ("Johnson Utilities" or the "Company") and Swing First Golf, LLC, ("SFG") hereby file this Joint Stipulation to Stay Docket pending the resolution of the Complaint re Decision of the Arizona Corporation Commission (A.R.S. § 40-254); Complaint for Special Action Review of Assertion of Jurisdiction by Arizona Corporation Commission; and For Review of Administrative Decision (A.R.S. § 12-901) (the "Appeal") filed by Johnson Utilities as Case No. CV2016-014825 with the Maricopa County Superior Court on September 7, 2016.

On February 22, 2016, Johnson Utilities filed a Motion to Dismiss the formal complaint filed in this docket by SFG. On June 30, 2016, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision 75616 denying the Company's Motion to Dismiss. Johnson Utilities filed the Appeal seeking to reverse Decision 75616 and challenging the Commission's jurisdiction over the Company's use of effluent.


In light of the Appeal, the parties agree that a stay of this docket is warranted because it will promote judicial economy and the efficient use of the parties' limited resources, as well as those of the Commission and its Utilities Division Staff ("Staff"). The parties further agree that they will comply with Decision 75616 while the stay is in place, pending the outcome of the Appeal. Legal counsel for Staff has authorized counsel undersigned to represent that Staff does not oppose the requested stay.

1 In the procedural order dated August 31, 2016, the administrative law judge ordered the
2 parties to jointly file, on or before September 12, 2016, an update with the Commission
3 discussing the status of the case. This Joint Stipulation to Stay Docket is submitted in lieu of the
4 filing of a status report.

5 Additionally, the procedural order directed Johnson Utilities to respond to SFG's Motion
6 for Sanctions filed in this docket on or before September 12, 2016. The Company is filing its
7 response to SFG's motion contemporaneously herewith. SFG will file its reply in support of its
8 motion on or before September 16, 2016.


