PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Consolidates Cases)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 20, 2016, Pima Utility Company (“PUC” or “Company”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) requesting authority to (1) issue evidence of indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$8,370,000 and (2) encumber real property and plant as security for such indebtedness for its wastewater utility system (“Sewer Docket”).

On October 20, 2016, PUC filed an application with the Commission requesting authority to (1) issue evidence of indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$8,370,000 and (2) encumber real property and plant as security for such indebtedness for its water utility system (“Water Docket”).

On October 21, 2016, PUC filed Motions to Consolidate in both the Sewer Docket and the Water Docket. PUC states that, by consolidating both applications, judicial resources would be better utilized as both dockets are for the same company.

The matters in the above captioned dockets are substantially related, and the rights of the parties will not be prejudiced by consolidation. The interests of judicial efficiency and administrative economy warrant consolidation of these matters.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Docket Nos. SW-02199A-16-0380 and W-02199A-16-**
2 **0381 are hereby consolidated for purposes of resolving the issues raised in each docket.**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party or prospective party shall **refer to the Procedural**
4 **Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **October 25, 2016** for additional
5 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to

7 Service Consent."


8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
11 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
12 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
14 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
15 hearing.
