On October 3, 2016, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Ryan Miguel aka Ryan Miguel Pina aka Ryan Lee Oliver, Robert E. Hawkins, and Infinity Fuels, Inc. (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts and/or membership interests.

On October 17, 2016, Respondents filed a Request for Hearing pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-4-306.

On October 27, 2016, Respondent Ryan Miguel filed a Request for extension of time to file his Answer to the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Request"). Respondent Miguel states he is in the process of seeking legal counsel to assist him in this matter.

On November 1, 2016, the Division filed its Response to Respondent Miguel's Request. The Division states it does not oppose Respondent Miguel's Request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED Respondent Ryan Miguel's Request for an extension of time

1 to file his Answer to the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing is granted. Respondent Ryan Miguel shall
2 file his Answer to the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing no later than **November 23, 2016**.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the **pre-hearing conference** remains scheduled for **November**
4 **28, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room
5 No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED each party or prospective party shall **refer to the Procedural**
7 **Order Regarding Consent to Email Service** issued in this matter on **October 20, 2016**, for additional
8 information regarding the process to consent to service by email. Information regarding Consent to
9 Email Service is also available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) by clicking on "Email
10 Service Consent."

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
12 Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter
13 is final and non-appealable.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31,
15 38 and 39, and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
17 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
18 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at
19 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled
20 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
21 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
23 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
24 ruling at hearing.
