### Nature Of Opinion

1. Customers should be given the choice to remain (be grandfathered) on their current plan for "On peak hours". This is already being done for current Solar customers. 2. If there is a Peak Usage Charge it should benefit the customer and utility. Example: use the one hour each month when the peak usage is highest and lowest and average them. 3. Any rate increase should have zero impact on employee bonuses or incentive payouts. Allowing rate increases to affect bonuses and incentive payouts could be considered a conflict of interest by an ACC representing consumers and recipient businesses. Here is a separate Solar Comment. I do not have solar (yet) and have been watching the conflict between solar and non-solar interests. Solar interests use the argument that through energy production have reduced the need for added power plant construction. They are continuously compensated for this by non-solar customers. Many non-solar customers have reduced home sizes or made energy efficiency improvements thereby reducing demand on the grid and need for added power plant construction and receive no continuous compensation for this from solar customers. This is inconsistent. Non-solar customers should not have to pay the grid support for solar customers. My suggestion is for all grid users to support the grid.
