UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS Electric"), and Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("MEC") through undersigned counsel, hereby submit this Joint Application to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of a Borderline Agreement between UNS Electric and MEC.

### BACKGROUND.

OF

UNS Electric is a public service corporation engaged in the generation, transmission and distribution of electricity for the purpose of serving its customers located within a specifically designated service area in portions of Santa Cruz and Mohave Counties, Arizona.

MEC is a member-owned electric cooperative public service corporation engaged in the distribution of electricity for the purpose of serving its customers located within a specifically designated service area in portions of Mohave, Yavapai, and Coconino Counties, Arizona.

#### II. REQUEST.

Mr. Victor Van Houten and Ms. Odetta Van Houten (collectively "Customer") are constructing a home at 13075 East Marble Drive, Kingman, Arizona ("Property") located in UNS Electric's certificated territory.

MEC has facilities in close proximity to the Property while UNS Electric facilities are located approximately 4000 feet from the Property. The estimated cost for UNS Electric to provide a line extension to the Property is \$65,000, whereas the estimated cost for MEC to extend facilities to the property is \$11,500. MEC has determined that it is willing to provide electric service to this Property.

At this time, it is in the best interest of the Customer and the public for MEC to serve the Property, under the terms of the Electric Service Authorization Agreement ("Agreement"), attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, until such time as UNS Electric determines it is economically feasible for UNS Electric to serve the Property.

#### III. ELECTRIC SERVICE AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT.

UNS Electric and MEC have entered into an Agreement for the Property, attached hereto as Exhibit A, in order for MEC to provide electric service to the Property subject to the Customer: 1) executing a non-member application for service, 2) paying any and all costs for the upgrade of MEC's existing facilities necessary to enable MEC to provide the requested service, 3) securing any and all easements and permits associated with MEC's provision of such service, and 4) paying all applicable deposits, fees, rates and charges associated with the requested class of service approved by the Commission for MEC's retail customers. In the event MEC intends to permanently cease providing power to the Customer, MEC will: 1) provide UNS Electric and Customer written notice thereof not less than 90 calendar days prior to permanently ceasing to take power from the Customer, and 2) coordinate with UNS Electric the exchange of the service, including the transfer of any facilities paid for by Customer and dedicated exclusively to providing service to the Property at no cost to UNS.

UNS Electric, MEC and Customer believe the Agreement to be consistent with and promote the public interest, and to be in the best interest of Customer.

UNS Electric has no outstanding line extension agreement with Customer or to the Property.

The transfer of facilities would not include structures from MEC's lines to the point of interconnection as reflected on Exhibit 2 to Exhibit A, which facilities will be retained by MEC.

1 There are no easements or rights-of-way to be transferred. The Customer shall be charged the 2 applicable Commission approved rate(s) by MEC. 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# **EXHIBIT A**

#### **ELECTRIC SERVICE AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT**

#### (BORDERLINE AGREEMENT)

THIS ELECTRIC SERVICE AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is entered into this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2017 by and between UNS Electric, Inc., an Arizona corporation ("UNS Electric") and Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated, an Arizona nonprofit corporation ("MEC").

#### RECITALS:

- A. The real property described and depicted in <u>Exhibit 1</u> attached hereto (the "Subject Area") is within the area of UNS Electric's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission");
- B. In UNS Electric's opinion, it is beneficial to the Mr. Victor Van Houten and Ms. Odetta Van Houten (collectively "Customer") for UNS Electric to permit MEC to provide electric service to the Customer so long as MEC is willing to provide as hereafter agreed.

#### PROMISES AND CONVENANTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and in further consideration of the following covenants, promises, and provisions, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto, for themselves, their agents, employees, successors and assigns, do hereby agree as follows:

- MEC is hereby authorized by UNS Electric to enter the Subject Area, certificated to UNS
  Electric, and construct and maintain electric service lines and facilities necessary to serve the electric
  needs of the Customer, as briefly depicted on <u>Exhibit 2</u>.
- 2. MEC is willing to provide electric service to the Customer, subject to Customer: a) executing a non-member application for service, b) paying any and all costs for the upgrade of MEC's existing facilities necessary to enable MEC to provide the requested service, c) securing any and all easements and permits associated with MEC's provision of such service, and d) paying all applicable deposits, fees, rates and charges associated with the requested class of service approved by the Commission for MEC's retail customers.
- 3. MEC shall provide UNS Electric and the Customer not less than ninety (90) days written notice of its intent to permanently cease serving the Customer. Upon receipt of such written notice, MEC and UNS Electric shall cooperate on the transferring of service to UNS Electric, including

transferring all of MEC's title and interest in those facilities paid for by the Customer and dedicated exclusively to serving the Customer, but excluding structures from MEC's lines to the point of interconnection as reflected on <a href="Exhibit 2">Exhibit 2</a>, which facilities will be retained by MEC. The transfer of such facilities from MEC to UNS Electric shall be at no cost to UNS Electric. Any upgrades of MEC's facilities used to serve other customers of MEC shall remain the property of MEC.

- MEC will then discontinue providing electric service to Customer on a date mutually agreed upon by MEC and UNS Electric.
- MEC and UNS Electric shall have no obligation, but may separately agree to allow MEC to retain any facilities UNS does not intend to use to serve the Customer.
- The transfer to UNS Electric of MEC's facilities dedicated exclusively to serve the Customer shall not be subject to further approval by the Commission.
- 7. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors in interest and assigns, whether arising voluntarily or by operation of law.
- 8. This Agreement shall become effective upon approval by the Commission.


