PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 12, 2017, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (“TracFone”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) to expand its eligible telecommunications carrier designation in the State of Arizona to include Tribal lands.

On January 19, 2017, the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association filed a Motion to Intervene.

No objections have been filed to Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association’s Motion to Intervene.

Accordingly, Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association’s intervention should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association is hereby granted intervention in this matter.


